What is the C.ROADS project?

The C-ROADS project: Advocating for climate change and justice through participatory skills building is funded by the ERASMUS+ Programme and aims to raise awareness among different audiences about the impact of climate change and the promotion of climate justice.

Through participatory research methods, the project aims to develop and make available new formal and informal learning methods to promote committed community participation in these domains.

What has already happened?

The Eugénio de Almeida Foundation, as coordinator of the C. ROADS Project: Advocating for climate change and justice through participatory skills building, held a pilot activity on July 9th, aimed at students, teachers, educators and other education professionals with an interest in climate change, with the aim of testing a methodology developed for the project's Pedagogical Kit.

The methodology tested in this pilot activity was the online Escape Rooms, thus promoting knowledge of new tools that allow us to develop and learn more about cross-cutting and specific themes on Climate Change. The feedback from the participants was very positive!

National Good Practices Project:

Forest Impact - This project aims to plant Miyawaki Forests in Portugal in both urban and rural environments, using the Miyawaki method.

This method, created by Akira Miyawaki (a Japanese botanist), is already known around the world for being highly effective in quickly and safely restoring degraded land, increasing biodiversity and creating more sustainable ecosystems.
